Oregon Republican Party Convention: RNC Delegation Elected!

Meet ORP's Congressional District Officers & RNC Delegates



Republican Precinct Committeepersons from all over the state of Oregon gathered in Salem on May 25 for Oregon Republican Party's quadrennial Convention. There they voted to select Delegates and Alternate Delegates to represent Oregon at the Republican National Convention in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, next month, as well as to select Congressional District Officers for the next four years.

Current members of the Republican National Committee from Oregon are Chair Justin Hwang, National Committeewoman Tracy Honl, and National Committeeman Solomon Yue. Accompanying them to the Republican National Convention will be Delegates and Alternate Delegates elected at the Convention.

National Committeewoman Tracy Honl, who will serve as the Oregon Delegation Chair, notes: "This delegation represents the wide diversity of today's Republican Party across the state of Oregon—young professionals, retired public servants, men, women, urban residents, and rural Oregonians. United in purpose, they will be an effective voice for Oregon Republicans at the national level."

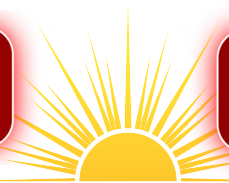

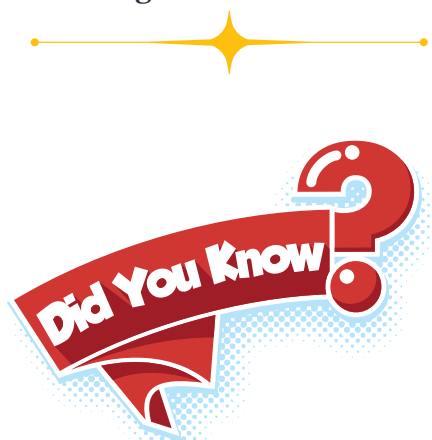
RNC Grassroots Training Opportunity

News from Oregon Senate Republicans



Key Races

These are some of the critical races in competitive districts that are key to the future of our efforts in the Oregon Senate.

Sen. Dick Anderson - Senate District 5

We are working diligently this election cycle to support Sen. Dick Anderson (R-Lincoln City) in Senate District 5. In his first term, Anderson has been an outstanding representative for the coast, showcasing a strong record of bipartisanship and tangible results.

Michael Summers - Senate District 27

Small business owner and Redmond School Board Member Michael Summers is running to retain Sen. Tim Knopp's seat in District 27, Bend. Summers is a dynamic candidate with lifelong roots in central Oregon. We are committed to keeping this seat red, and Summers is the ideal candidate to achieve this.

Raymond Love - Senate District 25

Insurance agent and Army Reserves Colonel Raymond Love of Gresham is working to flip District 25 in east Multnomah County. The surrounding communities are dissatisfied with Portland's conditions, plagued by crime, drug use, homelessness, and high living costs due to progressive policies. Raymond Love is uniquely equipped to address these issues, and we believe this seat is a viable pick-up. Our efforts will be relentless in supporting his campaign.

Safe Seats

All these incumbents and candidates are expected to secure victories in November. We are excited to welcome this strong slate of new and returning members to the Senate Republican Caucus, led by Senator Daniel Bonham (R-The Dalles) in 2025.

Sen. David Brock Smith - District 1

Sen. David Brock Smith (R-Port Orford) secured a decisive victory in his four-way primary in District 1 along the southern coast.

Sen. Fred Girod - District 9

Sen. Fred Girod (R-Stayton) won his uncontested primary in District 9 and faces no opponent in Nov.

Todd Nash for Senate District 29

Wallowa County Commissioner and cattle rancher Todd Nash won the Republican nomination for District 29 in northeastern Oregon.

Mike McLane for Senate District 30

Former House Republican Leader Mike McLane secured the nomination for District 30 in central and eastern Oregon.

Bruce Starr - Senate District 12

Former State Senator Bruce Starr won the nomination to represent rural Polk and Yamhill counties.

Diane Linthicum - Senate District 28

Diane Linthicum, wife of current Sen. Dennis Linthicum (R-Beatty), secured the nomination for District 28 in southern Oregon.

Noah Robinson - Senate District 2

Noah Robinson, son of current Sen. Art Robinson (R-Cave Junction), won the nomination for District 2 in southern Oregon.

News from Oregon House Republicans

Seats We Have to Defend

We must hold on to these crucial seats. Losing even one will allow Democrats to pass a slew of tax increases.

Jeff Helfrich, House District 52 – Hood River

The House Republican Caucus Leader, Rep. Helfrich flipped the seat last cycle in one of the most perennially competitive seats in Oregon. Under his leadership, Republicans recriminalized drugs and have fought to bring Oregon back to basics.

Kevin Mannix, House District 21 – Salem

Rep. Mannix has been a tireless advocate for affordability and common sense, tough on crime policies. A vocal opponent of Salem's recent payroll tax attempt, Mannix is one of three state legislators targeted by national Democrats in Oregon.

Tracy Cramer, House District 22 – Woodburn

Small business owner, Tracy Cramer shocked political insiders in 2022 by winning despite a substantial voter registration disadvantage. She is the second state legislator national Democrats have targeted this year.

Cyrus Javadi, House District 32 - Tillamook

A dentist by trade, Rep. Javadi is the third legislator national Democrats have targeted this election cycle. Rep. Javadi has fought for lower taxes and protection of our coastline.



Pick-up opportunities

Cory Burket, District 7 – Springfield

Cory Burket works in the construction industry as a business development and project manager with a long history of involvement in the Springfield community. He serves on the Springfield Area Chamber of Commerce Board, was previously the Regional Developer for a local nonprofit, and has owned a local franchise of Black Rock Coffee Bar.

David Brown, District 19 – South Salem

A 45-year resident of South Salem, David Brown attended Salem-Keizer's public schools. He served honorably in the U.S. Navy, raised a family, and owns and operates a small business with his wife and son.



More Pick-up opportunities

Jason Fields, District 26 – Washington, Clackamas Co.

Jason Fields is a native Oregonian, small business owner and Chehalem Parks and Recreation board member. He will fight to keep Oregon safe and affordable for working families and small businesses.

Aimee Reiner, District 39 – Clackamas County

Aimee Reiner is a school choice advocate who works as a senior sales manager in glass manufacturing. A former collegiate athlete and Army Reservist, Aimee is raising three children with her wife Michelle.

Michael Newgard, District 40 – Clackamas County

An Army Blackhawk helicopter pilot, Michael Newgard has performed daring rescues on Mt. Hood, and fought wildfires all over Oregon. He has been deployed to Syria and other parts of the Middle East where he flew medivac missions supporting US and NATO special forces. He is a fifth generation Milwaukie native where he lives with his wife Jackie and their daughter Reagan.

John Masterman, District 48 – Damascus, East Portland

John Masterman is a small business owner with a background in automotive parts and service. He has previously run in this district.

Terry Tipsord District 49 – Troutdale, Fairview, Gresham

A leader from a young age, Terry Tipsord was instrumental in helping grow downtown Troutdale and founding the Troutdale SummerFest. As a business advisor and small business owner, he supports providing education, resources, and safe communities for local businesses and families.

Paul Dreschler - District 50 – Gresham

Paul Dreschler is a father, small business owner, and community leader with a heart for supporting local organizations. He will protect our local families and small businesses from public safety and livability issues.

Keri Lopez - District 53 – Bend, south Redmond

Keri Lopez represents Redmond on the school board. Her family founded and operates Rogue Builders, LLC, and she and her husband are raising school-aged children.

The Jackson County Republican Party (JCRP) is on the move in southern Oregon! During the May 2024 primary elections, we significantly enhanced our effectiveness to boost voter registration and turnout. We updated our website with relevant information and community engagement opportunities, and attracted over 400 volunteers through completed contact forms. This influx of new volunteers has bolstered our efforts, complemented by a stronger presence both at community events and online. Consequently, with a 45% Republican voter turnout in the primary election, proposed changes to our county charter were halted, and a strong slate of Republican candidates was established.

Leading up to the primaries, we collaborated with Jackson County Republican Women (JCRW), local citizen groups, and the Stop Bigger Government PAC to inform voters about petitions aimed at changing the county charter. Over 40 volunteers set up numerous yard and field signs. We partnered with local businesses to provide locations for voters to pick up candidate yard signs. We also conducted canvassing, door-knocking campaigns, and initiated SMS text and voicemail outreach to deliver crucial information about candidates and primary ballot items. We led and supported multiple town halls, allowing Republican candidates to address key voter concerns.

The JCRP is now launching our general election campaign with the "Make Oregon Great Again" event on June 22 at the Jackson County Fairgrounds. This all-day event aims to rally support both for Presidential candidate Donald J. Trump and for our other great Republican candidates. Keynote patriot speakers include Mike Lindell, Dave Duquette, Joe Hoft, Andy Pollack, and Donna Kreitzberg. Those joining us will enjoy music from Nashville artist Mark MacKay, food trucks, merchandise tables, and informational booths for local and state representatives and organizations. 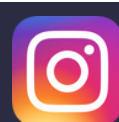
