Meet Will Lathrop!

Dear Neighbors,

Oregon is a wounded beauty – a beautiful state marred by crime, drug trafficking, and a lack of accountability. I don't need to tell you that our state is in crisis and is desperate for new leadership.

My name is Will Lathrop. I am a sixth-generation Oregonian who grew up on a cattle ranch in Joseph. Like you, it's been painful for me to watch the state I love suffer. It's why I'm running to serve as Oregon's next Attorney General. I'm an experienced prosecutor, proven leader, and dedicated public servant – not a politician.

My career in public service began as a child sex abuse prosecutor, working in Yamhill and Marion Counties for nine years. My focus was on being a voice for children and ensuring that they received justice.

I have always been an advocate for victims of crime, and in 2014, I joined a global human rights organization in Africa to protect women from violence in Uganda. I was then promoted to lead the West Africa anti-human trafficking operation in Ghana where I led a large multinational team to rescue children from forced labor and to prosecute child traffickers in court.

Oregon is failing to keep our children safe. We're seeing an unprecedented increase in fentanyl exposures, and a dramatic rise in online child exploitation, while foster children are being placed in hotel rooms. As the chief child protection officer, I am committed to bolstering child protection services, holding DHS and our foster care system accountable, and protecting vulnerable children.

Second, Oregon has a soft-corruption problem. Oregonians increasingly don't trust our elected leaders nor how our taxpayer dollars are spent. As Attorney General, I will investigate the misuse of taxpayer funds and crack down on public corruption.

Right now, our justice system is failing vulnerable Oregonians, and our communities don't feel safe. The drug cartels are making millions of dollars by exploiting an addiction crisis that is destroying communities and tearing families apart. Salem politicians have failed to protect victims and have sided with criminals over law enforcement. As Oregon's preeminent law enforcement officer, I will rebuild the Criminal Justice Division and develop collaborative strategies with state, local, and federal law enforcement authorities to combat organized crime and hold drug traffickers accountable.

My entire career has been dedicated to protecting children and vulnerable populations from violence, abuse, and exploitation – it's what I will do as your next Attorney General. I represent a new wave of leadership that is focused on solving problems and holding people accountable – not radical politics.

If you would like to support my campaign, volunteer, or have any questions, I would love to hear from you. I believe that together we can fix this.

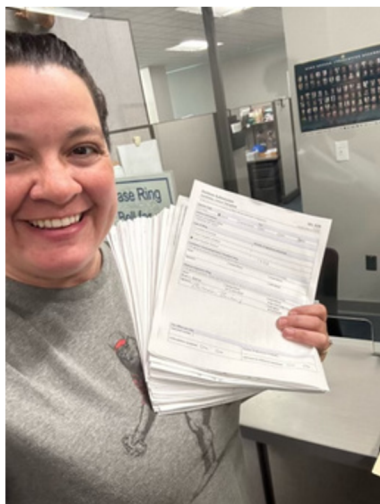

Ranked Choice Voting

As it stands today, collectively as a party, we turned in over 40 opposition statements against ranked choice voting with potentially more than that. The SOS had never seen anything like it before—so much so that they had to set a day aside just to process petitions. If my estimates are correct, that’s about 15,000 unique signatures in total. And if all are approved, it’s a value of nearly \$50,000 in grassroots opposition efforts that we made happen through hard work!

I’m excited to share that there are many opportunities to hear from Alaska’s Phil Izon speak about what he knows about RCV coming in September. As long as we continue advocating against this confusing, disenfranchising, easily manipulated, and impossible-to-audit voting scheme, we will have done all we can as a grassroots effort against this terrible idea.

We are up against an unlimited amount of dark money that’s being funneled into passing Ballot Measure 117, but together we have taken an axe to their plans and I know we will not quit until we chop it all the way down in defeat.

I am pleased to announce that Oregon Secretary of State accepted ORP’s official opposition statement to Ballot Measure 117, which would establish ranked choice voting in Oregon. We received nearly 1500 signatures with less than a 2-week turnaround time to beat the deadline.

I received petitions from all across the state and I want to list them by name. I am so grateful for everyone’s hard work to make this effort successful.

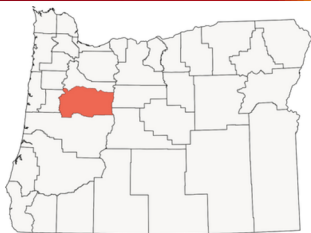

The Linn County Republican Central Committee is actively engaged in a series of dynamic initiatives aimed at promoting conservative values and supporting our candidates.

In July we gathered signatures at our county fair for our opposition statement to ranked-choice voting. Linn County was one of the first opposition statements successfully certified to include in the Oregon Voter's Pamphlet, ensuring that our community's voice is heard on this crucial issue. RCV can be prohibited by Home Rule Charter, and we are now petitioning local city councils to adopt our county resolution against RCV and planning for necessary steps for charter changes, if Measure 117 passes.

We're also rallying behind Congresswoman Lori Chavez-DeRemer, our champion for Congressional District 5, with a focused letter-writing campaign to encourage Republicans to get out and vote. Every letter is a step toward victory! We know that the opposition is incredibly organized and well-financed. This excerpt from one letter shows Lori's attention to constituents' needs, making a strong personal argument for supporting her in this race:

When my father, a retired government employee, passed at 94, there was a horrible mistake on my mother's benefits and the 'Operations Dept' wiped out both her checking and savings. We did everything to get it corrected but got zero help. We even reached out with this subject line- 'URGENT! Correction Needed! – Gross Error after Death of Retired Government Employee' to: Office of Personnel Management, Office of the Inspector General, Joe Biden, President, Jeff Zients, Chief of Staff, Ron Wyden and Jeff Merkley, Oregon Senators, and Lori Chavez-DeRemer, Congressional Rep, OR-5. ONLY ONE person from any branch responded . . .

Lori Chavez-DeRemer responded! She and her team CARED about our dire situation, calling us personally and writing emails. They took over, contacted WDC personnel and stayed in constant communication with us – they knew our stress with auto-pays and NSF's happening.

Good News: It got FIXED! Without question, Lori and her amazing team made it happen...

Excitement is building, too, as we prepare for our upcoming events, starting with the Linn Laughs comedy show on September 7th, featuring the one and only Adam Carolla.
